

POLICY ON CONTINUING COMPETENCY IN NEONATAL RESUSCITATION

The required standard of performance is completion of a course which meets or exceeds the Canadian Paediatric Society's Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) levels 1-9 with skills required for a primary care provider and as applicable within the midwife's scope of practice. The midwife will maintain NRP provider status through annual completion of NRP levels 1-9 provider course. It is every registrant's responsibility to regularly review and practice all of the components of NRP skills including intubation to maintain competence.

Where a midwife is a current NRP instructor the midwife will be considered to have met the above requirement when she provides evidence of:

- a) current NRP levels 1-9 instructor status; and
- b) having taught at least one NRP levels 1-9 course in the previous twelve months.
