

## Continuing Professional Development Scoring Framework

General and Temporary- Limited Scope Registrants are required to complete a minimum of forty five (45) continuing professional development (CPD) credits per 36-month (three year) cycle. Please note that CMBC endorses the College of Family Physicians of Canada's accreditation system and accepts Mainpro+ credits on par until CMBC has further developed their own accreditation system. This framework is designed to assist registrants in assigning CPD credits to a variety non- Mainpro+ accredited CPD activities. Details of all CPD activities and credits should be contemporaneously recorded in the CMBC *Continuing Professional Development Log*.

### CPD credit assignment for non- Mainpro+ accredited activities<sup>1</sup>

Hourly:

One credit per hour (0.25 credits per 15 minute increment)	Two credits per hour (0.50 credits per 15 minute increment)	Three credits per hour (0.75 credits per 15 minute increment)
Non- accredited seminar or conference presentation attendance	Journal club attendance  Presenting at a conference	Interprofessional, interactive workshops and/or simulation events
Hospital rounds attendance	Online, interactive modules or manuals  Formal clinical instruction  Related university course instruction  Midwifery curriculum review	Chart audits

Activity based:

Type of activity	Credit assignment
Reviewing print-based or flat media (i.e. journal articles, webinars, online rounds, podcasts) and completing CMBC reflective exercise	1 credit per activity completed
Preceptoring of midwifery, nursing or medical students/residents	3 credits per completed term

Serving on a panel, committee or Board of a related professional or regulatory organization (i.e. CMBC, MABC, SOGC, PSBC, CAM, etc.)	6 credits per year, per position held
Serving on a clinical committee or working group (i.e. patient safety, quality improvement, quality assurance, perinatal review, infection control etc.)	6 credits per year, per position held
Volunteering in a resource poor setting	3 credits per week of experience
Attendance at an event that supports cultural humility	3 credits per year, per event attended
Related university course	3 credits per course completed
Completion of a related Bachelor's degree	10 credits per year of full time studies, per degree
Publication of a journal article	10 credits per article published
Completion of a related Masters or PhD program	20 credits per year, per program
