

POLICY ON CESSATION OF PRACTICE¹ REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUING COMPETENCY IN NRP, CPR, EMERGENCY SKILLS AND CPD

A Non-Practising Registrant is not required to maintain continuing competence in Neonatal Resuscitation (NRP), Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Emergency Skills during the non-practising period.

A Non-Practising Registrant is required to comply with the *Policy on Continuing Professional Development*, whereby at least forty-five (45) credits of CPD activities must be completed per three-year period, unless they are non-practising for 12 or more consecutive months. For each 12-month period spent non-practising, CPD credits will be decreased by 15 credits per cycle.

The registrant must submit a completed *Application for Non-Practising Registration* form to the College of Midwives of BC (CMBC) before the intended date of status change. When a registrant intends to return to practice, they must inform CMBC by submitting a completed *Application for Return to Practice*, evidence of current certification in neonatal resuscitation, cardiopulmonary resuscitation and emergency skills, and if due, an up-to-date *Continuing Professional Development Log* at the point of return to practice.
